

What is a school zone?

- A school zone is an essential safety feature at our schools.
- It is designed to:
- · Slow down traffic; · Allow students to be safely dropped off
- and picked-up; • Give drivers more time to recognize and react to situations requiring slowing or
- stopping. A school zone begins at the School Speed 15 MPH when Flashing sign and ends at the End School Zone sign.

Tips for the road:

- Be aware of all school zones, keep your eyes on the road and your mind on the task at hand at all times.
- all immes. Stop for pedestrians at crossings, Remember they have the right of way. Follow the speed limit and SLOW DOWN to **15mph** in designated school zones when the light is flashing.
- Expect the unexpected. Children can be unpredictable. So always be alert and on the look-out.
- the look-out. When a school bus has stopped in front of you stop at least **20 feet** away and wait until the bus pulls away. NEVER overtake a school bus while it is off-loading children or its flashers are blinking.
